## The Library Object

The Library Object was produced for the Study Skills strand of The Learning Bank.

Created in response to the need for better support mechanisms within the libraries. Increasingly student induction to the library services is limited to sessions of 20 or 30 minutes at the beginning of the term.

To support this need the Library Object contains information on the lending and reference sections of the library and also introduces other resources.

The object also contains self test quizzes built into each section.



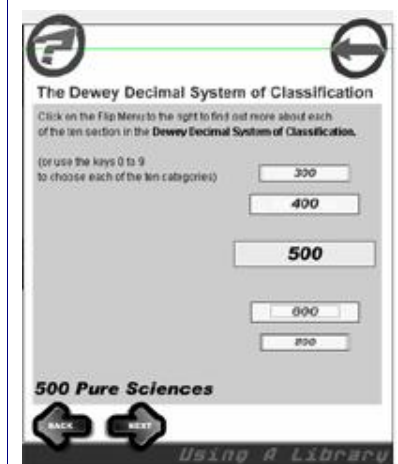
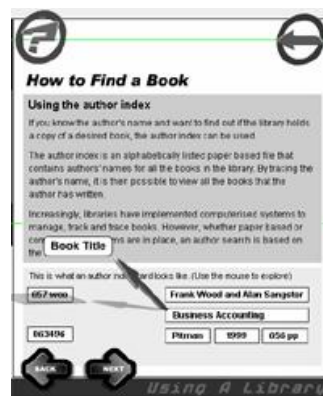
A screenshot of the main page of the Library Object

Throughout the content the student is guided by the Helper. The Helper is an animated character who guides the student through the information. Also he pops up as students leave a section if they have not looked at all the content available and suggest that they look at what they have missed.

There is also help from the Librarian who will guide the student through an interactive question and answer session designed to help the student find the information that they need within the library using the library systems.

# X4L: The Learning Bank – Business Studies – Health and Safety in the Workplace

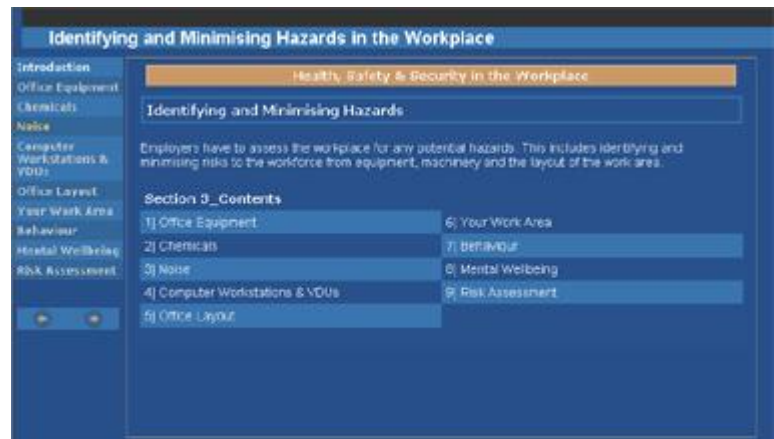

Including a range of animations to reinforce the information provided such as the Risk Assessment before and after shown below.



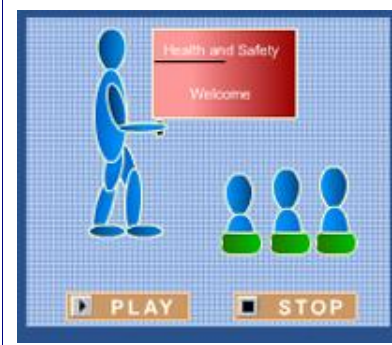
